

HB Reavis showcases its flagship projects at MIPIM 2015

HB Reavis, the international real estate development group operating in the key markets of Central and Eastern Europe, the United Kingdom and Turkey, will once again participate at this year's MIPIM international real estate show, which will take place on 10-13 March 2015 in the French city of Cannes. During this event, the developer will present a number of exciting projects, including its flagship developments in Poland and the United Kingdom.

- As one of the leading developers in Central and Eastern Europe, HB Reavis has been an active participant at MIPIM since 2004. as an investment proposition reinforces HB Reavis' reputation for being at the forefront of bringing high-quality, sustainable buildings to the European market.

HB Reavis will be present in Cannes with its own stand (P-1.E50), where it will showcase both completed and underway projects in Poland, the Czech Republic, Slovakia, the United Kingdom, and Hungary. Among these projects will be HB Reavis' major Polish office developments, Konstruktorska Business Center and Gdański Business Center, as well as its flagship British scheme, 33 Central in London.

Konstruktorska Business Center is the first investment completed by HB Reavis in Poland. The complex first opened to tenants in March 2013 is one of the most modern office buildings





in Warsaw. Situated in a burgeoning business district of the Polish capital city, it comprises over 48,000 sq m of office space. It also offers the largest single office floor in Central and Eastern Europe, at over 7,300 sq m. The building has achieved a 100% occupancy rate, with major tenants including Procter & Gamble, Żywiec (Heineken Group), PZU, Otis, Carrier, MoneyGram, and IMS Health.

A separate Warsaw-based investment to be presented during this year's edition of MIPIM is **Gdański Business Center.** This modern office complex, which will comprise four A-class buildings and offer the total area of over 98,000 sq m is one of the largest office developments currently under way in the broader city center of the Polish capital. The project's first phase offering over 46,000 sq m was completed in June 2014 and caters to leading international companies such as KPMG, Ove Arup & Partners and Provident. The second phase will comprise two buildings, with the total of over 50,000 sq m Grade A office space and is on schedule for completion in the first quarter of 2016.

HB Reavis will also be presenting its first British project during the week in Cannes. The construction of **33 Central** is currently underway in the City of London, in the very heart of the renowned business district at 33 King William Street. This modern Grade A office building has been designed by the distinguished John Robertson Architects. Tenants of this development, which is due to be completed by late 2016, will have more than 21,000 sq m of the highest quality office space at their disposal as well as a quarter acre rooftop garden overlooking the River Thames and other iconic London landmarks such as The Shard, St. Paul's Cathedral and London Bridge.

In addition to those outlined above, HB Reavis will also showcase further Group developments, such as the West Station project in Poland, Forum Business Center in Slovakia, the River Garden II/III complex in the Czech Republic and Váci Corner Offices in Hungary.

MIPIM is one the largest and most prestigious real estate events in Europe. It has been held annually since 1989. Last year's edition was attended by over 31 thousand participants from 93 countries, including developers, investors and numerous representatives of municipal authorities.
